

Draft Regulations Governing Food Allergen Labeling

1. These proposed regulations are drafted pursuant to Article 22, Paragraph 1, Subparagraph 9 of the Act Governing Food Sanitation.
2. All prepackaged food containing following substances which cause an allergic reaction in susceptible individuals shall be labeled with the warning information, including but not limited to the names of allergenic substances contained in the food product:
 - (1) Shrimp and products thereof
 - (2) Crab and products thereof
 - (3) Mango and products thereof
 - (4) Peanut and products thereof
 - (5) Milk and products thereof; except lactitol derived from milk
 - (6) Egg and products thereof
3. The warning information mentioned in the preceding paragraph should be separately and apparently indicated on the label of the container or external packaging - "This product contains _____ may cause an allergic reaction in susceptible individuals", "This product contains _____ may cause an allergic reaction", or other synonymous terms.
