In Annex III to Directive 2011/65/EU, point 6(b) is replaced by the following:

"6(b)	Lead as an alloying element in aluminium containing up to 0,4 % lead by weight	<ul> <li>Expires on:         <ul> <li>21 July 2021 for categories 8 and 9 other than in vitro diagnostic medical devices and industrial monitoring and control instruments;</li> <li>21 July 2023 for category 8 in vitro diagnostic medical devices;</li> <li>21 July 2024 for category 9 industrial monitoring and control instruments, and for category 11.</li> </ul> </li> </ul>
6(b)-I	Lead as an alloying element in aluminium containing up to 0,4 % lead by weight, provided it stems from lead-bearing aluminium scrap recycling	Expires on 21 July 2021 for categories 1-7 and 10.
6(b)-II	Lead as an alloying element in aluminium for machining purposes with a lead content up to 0,4 % by weight	Expires on [three years after the publication of the Delegated Directive in the Official Journal] for categories 1-7 and 10."
