

DRAFT OF PHYTOSANITARY IMPORT REQUIREMENTS
FOR SHALLOT BULBS (*Allium cepa* var. *Aggregatum*) PRODUCED IN FRANCE

1 - The shallot bulbs must be packed in first-use cardboard boxes, free of soil material and plant residues.

2 - The consignments of shallot bulbs must be accompanied by a Phytosanitary Certificate, issued by the National Plant Protection Organization - NPPO of France with the following Additional Declarations:

I - "The consignment has been inspected and is free from *Acrolepiopsis assectella*, *Delia antiqua*, *Delia floralis*, *Ditylenchus destructor*, *Dyspessa ulula*, *Liriomyza bryoniae*, *Myzus ascalonicus*, *Phytomyza gymnostoma* and *Rhizoglyphus echinopus*." and

II - "The consignment was treated with (*specify: product, dose or concentration, temperature, exposure time*) for the control of *Acrolepiopsis assectella*, *Delia antiqua*, *Delia floralis*, *Ditylenchus destructor*, *Dyspessa ulula*, *Liriomyza bryoniae*, *Myzus ascalonicus*, *Phytomyza gymnostoma* and *Rhizoglyphus echinopus* under official supervision. " and

III - "The consignment is free from *Ditylenchus destructor* and *Erwinia rhapontici* according to the result of the official analysis of laboratory N° (...).

IV - Alternatively to the additional declaration in item III, "The consignment does not present a quarantine risk with respect to the pests *Ditylenchus destructor* and *Erwinia rhapontici* considering the application of the Integrated System of Phytosanitary Measures of Risk Mitigation (System Approach), officially supervised and agreed with Brazil."

3 - In case of the use of the additional declaration of item IV, the import of shallot bulbs shall be conditional on compliance with the implementation by the NPPO of France of the Integrated System of Phytosanitary Measures of Risk Mitigation (System Approach) agreed with Brazil.

4 - The consignments of shallot bulbs will be inspected at the entry point (Phytosanitary Inspection), and samples may be collected for phytosanitary analysis in official laboratories or accredited by the Ministry of Agriculture, Livestock and Food Supply.

5- Regarding the collection of samples, the costs of shipping and analysis will be a burden for the importer, who may, at the discretion of the agricultural inspection, be the depository of the remaining samples until the conclusion of the analysis and issuance of the respective laboratory reports.

6 - In case of interception of quarantine pests, the consignment will be destroyed or rejected and the NPPO of France will be notified; therefore, the NPPO of Brazil may suspend imports until the review of the Pest Risk Analysis (PRA).

7 - The NPPO of France shall notify the NPPO of Brazil of any change in the phytosanitary status of the regions of production of shallot bulbs to be exported to Brazil.

8 - The product will not be internalized when it does not comply with the requirements established in this Normative Instruction.
