Note: The residue definition for agricultural products is triforine only. The residue definition for animal products is the sum of triforine and its metabolites converted to chloral hydrate in acidic conditions, expressed as triforine.

1. "Other composite vegetables" refers to all composite vegetables, except burdock, salsify, artichoke, chicory, endive, shungiku, lettuce (including cos lettuce and leaf lettuce), and herbs.

2. "Other herbs" refers to all herbs, except watercress, nira, parsley stems and leaves, celery stems and leaves.
3. "Other terrestrial mammals" refers to all terrestrial mammals, except cattle and pig.
4. "Edible offal" refers to all edible parts, except muscle, fat, liver, and kidney.
