Guideline for Phytosanitary Management for Export of Vehicle and Machinery

1. Scope and Purpose

- A. This guideline should be applied to the export of vehicles and machineries where the issuance of a certificate is required by the import country.
- B. This guideline is applied to export vehicles and machineries in accordance with the Plant Protection Act of Rep. of Korea.

2. Cleaning

- A. In case of that cleaning is required by an import country, the inside and outside of the vehicles and machineries should be cleaned to remove soil, pest, weed seeds, and plant debris etc.
- B. The exporter may issue a “Certificate of Cleaning” (Annex 1. in this guideline) after the cleaning process is completed.
- C. The exporter should ensure to prevent the vehicles and machineries from re-contamination before they are exported.

3. Disinfection treatment

- A. In case that an import country requires the phytosanitary treatment of vehicles and machineries, the exporter should ensure the treatment is applied by a treatment provider registered in Animal and Plant Quarantine Agency (hereinafter referred to as “APQA”).
- B. The treatment should be conducted according to the condition requested by the import country. In case that there is no specific treatment schedule requested by import country, the treatment provider should apply treatment as follows;

- C. After the treatment, the exporter should prevent re-contamination of the vehicles and machineries before they are exported.

4. Application for Export Inspection

- A. In case that the import country requires a phytosanitary certificate for cleaning and/or treatment for the vehicles or machineries for export, the exporter should apply for export inspection to APQA.
- B. In order to certify the treatment of vehicles and machineries by phytosanitary certificate, the exporter should submit a “Treatment Task Report” (Annex 3. in Treatment Regulation of Korea) to APQA.
- C. In order to certify the cleaning of vehicles and machineries by phytosanitary certificate, the exporter should submit a “Certificate of Cleaning” (Annex 1. in this guideline) to APQA.

5. Export Inspection

- A. APQA inspectors should inspect the vehicles and machineries after reviewing the documents in accordance with Korea’s Plant Protection Act.
- B. In case of the inspection results are appropriate to comply the requirement of the importing country, APQA issues the phytosanitary certificate.
- C. In case of non-compliance with the requirements of the import country, APQA inspectors order to conduct re-treatment and re-cleaning.
