



Notification of the Ministry of Public Health

**Re: Criteria, Methods and Conditions for Information Submission by Manufacturers or Importers Engaging in Sale of Cigarette Tobacco Products in the Kingdom
B.E. 2562 (2019)**

By virtue of Section 5 para 1 and Section 40 of the Tobacco Products Control Act 2017, the Minister of Public Health, as advised by the National Tobacco Products Control Board, hereby issues the notification as follows:

Article 1: This Notification shall be referred to as “the Notification of the Ministry of Public Health Re: Criteria, Methods and Conditions for Information Submission by Manufacturers or Importers Engaging in Sale of Cigarette Tobacco Products in the Kingdom B.E. 2562.”

Article 2: This Notification shall come into force 365 days from the date of its publication in the Government Gazette.

Article 3: In this Notification

“Marketing expenses” refers to any expenses arising from business activities related to goods or services targeted at consumers and conducted by a manufacturer or an importer, price determination, marketing promotion, or distribution of goods or services to entail the exchange of goods or services, thereby achieving customer satisfaction and the objectives of a juristic person.

“Annual report of juristic person” refers to history, management structure, products, and information about major current and future investments.

“Balance sheet approved by a certified public accountant” refers to any financial statement showing financial position or changes in financial position of an enterprise, whether it be reported by balance sheet, profit and loss statement, retained earnings statement, cash flow statement, statement of changes in shareholders equity, supplementary statement or notes to financial statements, or other explanations which are indicated that they are part of financial statements.

Article 4: Tobacco product manufacturers or importers shall prepare and submit information related to cigarette tobacco products manufactured or imported for sale in the kingdom to the National Tobacco Products Control Board as follows:

- (1) Information about production or import amounts;
- (2) Marketing expenses;
- (3) Revenue;
- (4) Expenses arising from the implementation of activities under Section 35 of the Tobacco Products Control Act 2017;
- (5) Annual report of juristic person;
- (6) Balance sheet approved by a certified public accountant.

The information under para 1 shall be fully submitted within the month of June of the following year.

Article 5: In case any problems arising from compliance with or implementation of this Notification, the National Tobacco Products Control Board shall make the final decision.
