Draft Regulation for The Use Restrictions and Labeling Requirement of Aloe as a Food Ingredient

Article 1

The regulation is prescribed in accordance with the provisions of Paragraph 2 of Article 15-1 and Subparagraph 10 of Paragraph 1 of Article 22 of the Act Governing Food Safety and Sanitation.

Article 2

Only the completely peeled leaves of *Aloe vera* and *Aloe ferox* can be used as food ingredients.

Article 3

Food products containing the aloe leaves referred to in *Article 2* shall comply with the following requirements:

- 1. The aloin content shall not exceed 10 ppm.
- 2. The labelling of food products shall bear the following warning statement: Women on menstrual period, pregnancy and lactation, children and patients with digestive tract, liver or kidney diseases are not recommended to consume.

Article 4

The regulation will be implemented on 1 January 2022. Food products containing aloe which are manufactured before the implementation date, can be placed on the market until their expiry date.
