- Certification and enforcement authority.- The Bureau shall be the certifying and enforcing authority in respect of the goods or articles specified in column (1) of the Table.
- Penalty for contravention. -Any person who contravenes the provisions of this order shall be punishable under the provisions of the said Act.
- Date of effect of amendment or revision in Indian Standards.- This order shall apply to any amendment or revision made by the Bureau to the Indian Standards specified in the Table with effect from Table
