## Government of India Ministry of Chemicals and Fertilizers (Department of Chemicals and Petrochemicals) Order

- S.O.———(E).- In exercise of the powers conferred by section 16 and section 17 of the Bureau of Indian Standards Act, 2016 (11 of 2016), the Central Government, after consulting the Bureau of Indian standards, is of the opinion that it is necessary or expedient so to do in the public interest, hereby makes the following Order, namely:-
- 1. Short title, commencement and application. (1) This Order may be called the Phosphorous Oxycholride (Quality Control) Order, 2020.
  - (2) This Order shall come into force on the One hundred and eighty first days from the date of its publication in the Official Gazette.
  - (3) It shall apply to goods or articles specified in column (1) of the Table, but nothing herein shall apply to such goods or articles meant for export.
- 2. Conformity to Standard and Compulsory use of Standard Mark.- Goods or articles specified in the column (1) of the Table shall conform to the corresponding Indian Standard given in the column (2) of the Table and shall bear the Standard Mark under a licence from the Bureau as per Scheme-I of Schedule-II of BIS (Conformity Assessment) Regulations, 2018.
- 3. Certification and Enforcement Authority In respect of the goods or articles specified in the column (1) of the Table, the Bureau shall be the certifying and enforcing authority.
- **4. Penalty for Contravention.** Any person who contravenes the provisions of this Order shall be punishable under the provisions of the Bureau of Indian Standards Act, 2016.
