NOTE: The residue definition for Trenbolone Acetate is β -Trenbolone[(17 β)-17-Hydroxyestra-4,9,11-trien-3-one] only for cattle muscle and fat, whereas α -Trenbolone[(17 α)-17-Hydroxyestra-4,9,11-trien-3-one] only for cattle edible offal. For livestock products, seafood and honey (include royal-jelly) for which the draft standard value is N.D., it indicates that β -Trenbolone and/or α -Trenbolone should not be detected in food.

The current residue definition is α -Trenbolone for cattle liver, β -Trenbolone for cattle muscle, and sum of β -Trenbolone and α -Trenbolone for cattle edible offal and foods labeled N.D..

* Shaded figures indicate provisional MRLs.

1. "Other terrestrial mammals" refers to all terrestrial mammals, except cattle and pig.
2. "Edible offal" refers to all edible parts, except muscle, fat, liver and kidney.
3. "Other poultry" refers to all poultry, except chicken.
4. "Other fish" refers to all fish, except Salmoniformes, Anguilliformes and Perciformes.
5. "Other aquatic animals" refers to all aquatic animals, except fish, shelled molluscs and crustaceans.
