Azoxystrobin

The standards for use of Azoxystrobin were revised as follows (underlined parts were added):

Current regulations

Azoxystrobin is permitted for use only on citrus fruits (excluding $unsh\bar{u}$ oranges). It shall not remain at levels exceeding 0.010 g/kg in citrus fruits (excluding $unsh\bar{u}$ oranges) as azoxystrobin.

Revised regulations

Azoxystrobin is permitted for use only on citrus fruits (excluding $unsh\bar{u}$ oranges) and potatoes.

It shall not remain at levels exceeding 0.010 g/kg in citrus fruits (excluding $unsh\bar{u}$ oranges) and at 0.007 g/kg in potatoes as azoxystrobin.

The chemical name of Azoxystrobin was partially revised as follows:

Revised name

Methyl (E)-2-({2-[6-(2-cyanophenoxy)pyrimidin-4-yl]oxy} phenyl)-3-methoxyacrylate
