### Azoxystrobin アゾキシストロビン

The standards for use of Azoxystrobin were revised as follows (underlined parts were added):

#### Current regulations

Azoxystrobin is permitted for use only on citrus fruits (excluding *unshū* oranges).  
It shall not remain at levels exceeding 0.010 g/kg in citrus fruits (excluding *unshū* oranges) as azoxystrobin.

#### Revised regulations

Azoxystrobin is permitted for use only on citrus fruits (excluding *unshū* oranges) and potatoes.  
It shall not remain at levels exceeding 0.010 g/kg in citrus fruits (excluding *unshū* oranges) and at 0.007 g/kg in potatoes as azoxystrobin.

The chemical name of Azoxystrobin was partially revised as follows:

#### Current name

Methyl(*E*)-2-{2-[6-(2-cyanophenoxy)pyrimidin-4-yloxy]phenyl}-3-methoxyacrylate

#### Revised name

Methyl (*E*)-2-({2-[6-(2-cyanophenoxy)pyrimidin-4-yl]oxy} phenyl)-3-methoxyacrylate
