### Paragraph 10

1. 2 insects (*Contarinia maculipennis*, *Pseudaulacaspis dendrobii*), 2 weeds (*Muhlenbergia capillaris*, *M.reverchonii*) were added to the regulated pest list.
2. “*Impatiens necrotic spot virus*, Tospovirus” is removed.
3. “*Didymella ligulicola*” is changed to “*Stagonosporopsis chrysanthemi* (anamorph : *Didymella ligulicola*)”

## Summary of the Draft Amendment of the “Quarantine Requirements for Wood Packaging Material used in Imported Commodity”

1. Two wood packaging material (WPM) treatment methods (Dielectric heating and Sulphuryl fluoride fumigation) in accordance with International Standards for Phytosanitary Measures No. 15 (ISPM 15) are added.
2. Example of the specified mark of the 2 new WPM treatment methods are added.
