amending Annex XVII to Regulation (EC) No 1907/2006 of the European Parliament and of the Council as regards undecafluorohexanoic acid (PFHxA), its salts and PFHxA-related substances

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ANNEX

In Annex XVII to Regulation (EC) No 1907/2006, the following entry is added:

- '... [OP please insert the next consecutive number].
- Undecafluorohexanoic acid (PFHxA), its salts and PFHxA-related substances:
 - (a) having a linear or branched perfluoropentyl group with the formula C₅F₁₁- directly attached to another carbon atom as one of the structural elements; or
 - (b) having a linear or branched perfluorohexyl group with the formula C_6F_{13} -.

The following substances are excluded from this designation:

- (a) C_6F_{14} ;
- (b) C_6F_{13} -C(=O)OH, C_6F_{13} -C(=O)O-X' or C_6F_{13} - CF_2 -X' (where X' = any group, including salts);
- (c) any substance having a perfluoroalkyl group C_6F_{13} directly attached to an oxygen atom at one of the non-terminal carbons.

- 1. Shall not, from [PO: please insert the date = 24 months from the date of entry into force of this Regulation] be placed on the market, or used, in a concentration equal to or greater than 25 ppb for the sum of PFHxA and its salts, or 1000 ppb for the sum of PFHxA-related substances, measured in homogeneous material, in the following:
 - textiles, leather, furs and hides in clothing and related accessories for the general public;
 - footwear for the general public;
 - paper and cardboard used as food contact materials within the scope of Regulation (EC) No 1935/2004;
 - mixtures for the general public;
 - cosmetic products as defined in Article 2(1), point (a), of Regulation (EC) No 1223/2009.
- 2. Shall not, from [PO: please insert the date = 36 months from the date of entry into force of this Regulation] be placed on the market, or used, in a concentration equal to or greater than 25 ppb for the sum of PFHxA and its salts, or 1000 ppb for the sum of PFHxA-related substances, measured in homogeneous material, in textiles, leather, furs and hides, other than in clothing and related accessories referred to in paragraph 1, for the general public.
- 3. Shall not, from *[PO: please insert the date = 18 months from the date of entry into force of this Regulation]* be placed on the market, or used, in a concentration equal to or greater than 25 ppb for the sum of PFHxA and its salts, or 1000 ppb for the sum of PFHxA-related substances, in:
 - fire-fighting foams for training and for testing (except functional testing of the firefighting systems);
 - fire-fighting foams for municipal fire services.
- 4. Shall not, from [PO: please insert the date = 5 years from the date of entry into force of this Regulation] be placed on the market, or used, in fire-fighting foams for civil aviation in a concentration equal to or greater than 25 ppb for the

sum of PFHxA and its salts, or 1000 ppb for the sum of PFHxA-related substances.

- 5. Paragraphs 1, 2, 3 and 4 shall not apply to substances having a perfluoroalkyl group C_6F_{13} -directly attached to a sulphur atom.
- 6. By way of derogation from paragraph 1, that paragraph shall not apply to articles placed on the market before [PO: please insert the date = 24 months from the date of entry into force of this Regulation].
- 7. By way of derogation from paragraph 2, that paragraph shall not apply to articles placed on the market before [PO: please insert the date = 36 months from the date of entry into force of this Regulation].
- 8. For the purposes of this entry, PFHxA-related substances are substances that, based on their molecular structure, are considered to have the potential to degrade or be transformed to PFHxA.
