- **S.O.-----(E).** -- In exercise of the powers conferred by section 16 read with section 17 and sub-section (3) of section 25 of the Bureau of Indian Standards Act, 2016 (11 of 2016), the Central Government is of the opinion that it is necessary so to do in the public interest and after consulting the Bureau of Indian Standards, hereby makes the following Order, namely: -
- 1. **Short title and commencement.-** (1) This order may be called the Textiles Polypropylene (PP) Woven, Laminated, Block Bottom Valve Sacks for Packaging of 50 kg Cement (Quality Control) Order, 2023.
- (2) It shall come into force on the expiry of one hundred and eighty days from the date of its publication in the Official Gazette.
- 2. **Application.-** It shall apply to goods or article specified in column (1) of the Schedule annexed to this order and shall not apply to goods or article meant for export.
- 3. Conformity to standard and compulsory use of Standard Mark. -- Goods or articles specified in column (1) of the said Schedule shall conform to the corresponding Indian Standard specified in column (2) of the said Schedule and shall bear the Standard Mark under a licence from the Bureau of Indian Standards in accordance with Scheme-I of Schedule-II to the Bureau of Indian Standards (Conformity Assessment) Regulations, 2018.
- 4. **Certifying and enforcing authority.-** The Bureau of Indian Standards shall be the certifying and enforcing authority in respect of the goods or article specified in column (1) of the said Schedule.
